**2nd Grade -** December is an exciting month in second grade. We are writing letters to Santa and learning how to write five sentence paragraphs. On Friday, December 2, we will walk down to Santa's mailbox in Afton and send our letters to the North Pole. Lucky for us, we have been extra good this year!

In math we are memorizing our basic facts and learning 2-digit addition and subtraction. We are also focusing on reading non-fiction books! They are amazing because you can learn so many cool facts! This is a busy month for all of us. Please help your child stay healthy by getting to bed on time and by eating healthy foods this month.

**3rd Grade -** We are into our third reading period now. We have some great, hardworking readers in third grade! We have studied both nonfiction and fiction texts. We are getting better at stopping to notice things as we read. Ask your students questions about what they are reading. They love to talk about the stories they read and the things they are learning. We have taught a couple science units. By the end of the year, each class will have rotated around to all the teachers for a total of five science units. In writing, we are now working on our opinion writing. We are sure that in a few short weeks, your students will be able to convince you of almost anything! We are wrapping up our unit on multiplication and division this month. Please keep skip-counting and practicing math facts at home. Students need a lot of repetition in order to transfer the knowledge to long term memory. We'll start addition and subtraction in December. Thanks for all your help and support!

## **Nurses Corner**



# Reminders about safety with Medications at school:

If a student requires medication during the school day, please be sure to contact the School Nurse to come up with an administration plan and complete appropriate forms.

<u>Students who "self-carry" their medication</u>, must have an approved medical plan AND are only allowed to carry enough medication for ONE DAY at a time. The medication must be in a labeled container with the student's name and the medication name.

<u>Prescription medication</u> must be in the original prescription bottle labeled with the student's name, medication name, dose/strength, instructions for administration and expiration date. (You can request an extra container with a label from the pharmacy for school doses.)

Over the counter medication must be in the original, sealed, container and be clearly labeled with the student's name (be sure it's not expiring).

Prescription medications need to be brought to school by a parent and then counted with staff upon receipt. They CANNOT be sent to school in a student's backpack. They could be harmful if taken by the wrong student and some medications are Controlled Substances. It's important they're labeled, so lost medications can be returned to the appropriate school/student.
