#### **Learning Update**

**Kindergarten -** Kindergarteners have been working hard learning how to write letters the correct way based on letter stroke progression. We will continue to practice correct letter formation this month. In kindergarten, we will continue to strengthen our phonemic awareness skills using Heggerty. Heggerty is a program that uses auditory-based word play to strengthen students' understanding of the spoken language. An example of this is: say "cat", now say "cat" and change /c/ to /b/. Students substitute the beginning sound to change the word "cat" to the word "bat". This understanding of the spoken language will help students become stronger readers and writers. Kindergarteners will continue working on becoming excellent storytellers as they practice being authors and illustrators. Kindergarteners will work on adding more details to their pictures, labeling parts of their pictures, and adding more sounds to their words.

Kindergarten mathematicians are working on sorting objects into common categories. We will review numbers 6-10 and focus on number recognition, number writing, counting, comparing quantities, and playing various number games.

1st Grade - Down in First Grade-ville, the students you'll see, Are working quite hard as December draws near! Their math brains are buzzing, oh, the numbers they know! Adding and subtracting within twenty, they're starting to glow! And then in phonics, why, they're learning so many things! There's -es, -ed, -ing, flying in on quick wings! With open and closed syllables, clever and bright, Their reading grows stronger by day and by night.

The writing is "How-To," with steps clear and neat, And crafting that fills all their days with a treat. But the most wondrous sight you'll soon surely see Is the Grinch show they'll perform on December 18th Oh my! Oh me!

Now the Grinch's small heart (as you surely recall)
Needs help growing bigger, three sizes in all!
So kindness is spreading from student to student,

**2nd Grade -** Can you believe the holidays are here? The school year is flying by. We're going to work hard and see how much learning we can get done before we're off for Christmas break. We do have some fun things in store. We will write letters to Santa Claus and then take our 2nd grade traditional walk to Santa's mailbox to mail them ourselves. We will be working on our double digit subtraction this month so practice some subtraction math facts with them at home. This can be simple and done in fun ways such as with dice or game cards. But don't completely abandon addition since we would like the 2nd graders to be able to pass off their 5 minute addition timings by the end of December. We will be doing our winter oral reading fluency benchmark in December and hope all our students have grown in their reading skills from the

**3rd Grade -** We appreciate all of the families that came to parent teacher conferences. This month we celebrated Veterans by joining in a school wide celebration in the gym. We have been working on multiplication and division in math. Students are also solving two step word problems using all four operations. Working with 2 step word problems can be challenging and we have been impressed with the students' work ethic and grit. We have just finished our "choice" writing unit where students had a choice if they wanted to write; poetry, fantasy, fairy tale, realistic fiction or historical fiction. Students worked diligently and produced some great pieces. We celebrated the end of our writing unit by sharing our writing in the POD. We are working on non-fiction reading strategies of the main idea and supporting details. Please remind your students to use text features to help them while they are reading their non fiction

texts. Thank you for all your support. The students showed off their multiplication skills while participating in our "multiplication carnival". Coach Taylor had the kids create goals for themselves for the turkey trot, and each student strived to meet their individual goals. Please continue to encourage your students to read at home at work on their multiplication and division facts.
