Learning Update

Kindergarten - We had so much fun giving our best effort during the Turkey Trot! One of the highlights was watching teachers and staff get pied—our kindergarteners thought that was *hilarious*!

In the classroom, kindergarteners are continuing to work on writing letters correctly while strengthening their phonemic awareness skills. We are also writing personal narratives, focusing on telling stories with a clear beginning, middle, and end. In math, our mathematicians are learning to compare numbers by identifying which numbers are greater than, less than, or equal to one another. We are continuing to review numbers 0–10 with a focus on number recognition, number writing, counting, number order, and playing a variety of fun number games. Coming up next, we will begin exploring teen numbers and adding numbers 11–20 to our learning!

1st Grade - December flew by, and first grade is excited to start the new year with fresh energy, big curiosity, and lots of learning!

We are proud of the hard work our first graders demonstrated in 2025 and are excited to see the growth, learning, and success that 2026 will bring!

2nd Grade - A new year! This month we will be finishing our AIMS testing and will be doing our reading comprehension and our math benchmarks so please do your best to get your child to school. We look forward to seeing how our students have grown in the first half of the year. We loved seeing all the growth the students had made on their oral reading fluency in December. Amazing! This month in math we will be focusing on adding and subtracting 3-digit numbers. In writing we will be writing paragraphs.

Some things you can do at home: help your child build their comprehension skills at home by discussing what you read together. Help them practice recalling details and ideas. Also continue practicing those math facts at home. We hope most students have passed off their addition fluency by now, which is the goal for this time of year. We would like the student to move toward mastering subtraction facts. We're excited for a new year and for a chance for the students to

Our comprehension focus has been on nonfiction text structures; cause and effect, main idea and supporting details, and sequence.
